Introduction

This pack contains the information required for manufacturers to understand the process of CE marking toys (and 'toy-like' products) and the tools to allow you to successfully complete the process for your own products.

You may wish to submit your products for third party testing or obtain copies of some standards, but all other information you need should be contained here. If you have any questions or queries, or would like a Conformance engineer to check your work, please use the hours of consultancy time included with this pack. We are here to help and wish to ensure that you are happy and confident with your CE marking.

Two of the documents in this pack are Word documents for you to edit. They are the Technical File and the Declaration of Conformity. You will need to complete these for your product as part of the CE marking process, and this document explains how.

Flowchart

This is a 'visual index' of the CE marking toys procedure. The procedure is explained in detail in this document but the flowchart gives a much simpler presentation of the process of CE marking toys. You should also use the flowchart as a checklist to make sure you have completed each stage of the process and to remind you of where you are up to when waiting for external input, e.g. waiting for test results for your products, or for Conformance to comment on your Technical File. You should only proceed through the sections as you complete them.

Some of the sections of the flowchart only apply to certain toys, such as electrical ones. Therefore, you may not need to deal with every item on it. The 'main path' that most non-electrical toys would require is highlighted on the flowchart for ease of use.

The section numbers on the flowchart are references to the section numbers in this document. There you will find information to either help you choose the correct path on the Flowchart or to give further information on a particular topic.

Procedure for CE marking toys

This section explains the CE marking process for toys and toy-like items. It mainly deals with the Essential Safety Requirements and administrative requirements of the TSD (Toy Safety Directive). It also deals with the requirements of other directives that may apply.

Due to the depth and breadth of information covered in this section, it is not possible to include all relevant information or cover every aspect of CE marking in detail. Where significantly more detail is required, links to specific pages of the Conformance web site are provided. However, for most products these should not be needed.
